Scholarship/Bursary 2006

We are pleased to inform you that we have given out 6 scholarships and 14 bursaries to deserving students who have achieved academically and made significant contribution to the school. SpeedPlus for Secondary 3 and 4 students

This is a school initiative in collaboration with students from Raffles Junior College to help students develop and inculcate a healthy and effective study habit and **improve examination results**. There will be 30 contact hours of small group tuition over the next 3 to 4 months covering topics in Maths and Science and 18 hours of activities (Please see attached information sheet). To enable more students to participate in this programme, the school is pleased to provide the following subsidies:

- (a) For first 20 students, each student only pays S\$350 and enjoys a subsidy of S\$250.
- (b) For next 20 students, each student only pays S\$450 and enjoys a subsidy of S\$150.
