Promotion Criteria

Promotion from Secondary 3 to Secondary 4 will be based on students' internal assessment results. Students must obtain passes in English and 3 other subjects to be promoted to Secondary 4. Students must have a minimum attendance rate of 90% in all their classes.

External Examinations

The Pearson Edexcel International GCSE examinations are held twice a year, in January and May. Certain subjects such as English as a Second Language, Chinese Language, History, and ICT are only available during the May examination.

Pathways upon Completion of Course

The Pearson Edexcel International GCSE is accepted for enrolment in the International Advanced Level programs, or in tertiary institutions where the respective subjects requirements are met. It is also an ideal preparation for higher level courses at St Francis Methodist School, which offers:

- Preparatory Course for Pearson Edexcel International Advanced Level (IAL) Pre-University 1 & 2
- Preparatory Course for Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) Year 11 & 12
