

# Preparatory Course for Singapore-Cambridge General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level)

The Preparatory Course for Singapore-Cambridge GCE 'O' Level Programme is a two-year programme that prepares students to be proficient in one or two languages, mathematics, science and humanities. The Singapore-Cambridge GCE 'O' Level programme is jointly examined by the University of Cambridge International Examination (CIE), the Ministry of Education (MOE), Singapore and the Singapore Examination and Assessment Board (SEAB).
