The Singapore-Cambridge GCE O-Level Programme is a two-year programme that prepares students to be proficient in one or two languages, mathematics, science and humanities. The Singapore-Cambridge GCE O-Level programme is jointly examined by the Cambridge Assessment International Examination (CAIE), the Ministry of Education (MOE), Singapore and the Singapore Examination and Assessment Board (SEAB).
