

# Cambridge Primary Programme (Year 1 - 6)

Cambridge Primary Checkpoint offered by SFMS is designed for international students looking for an International Primary School in Singapore. It incorporates international benchmarking in terms of curriculum, assessment, and awarding with the rigour, elements of local education and practices that has made Singapore education admired around the world. The Cambridge Primary Checkpoint programme is diagnostic in nature, with progression tests from Year 3 to Year 6 to help track each student's progress. The Checkpoint tests will be conducted at the end of Year 6 to gauge the student's readiness for secondary school.
